Swimming continues to thrive in our geographically-challenged region, with swimmers coming from as far north as Kaitaia and as far south as Wellsford to compete at Northland events, held at pools in Dargaville, Kawakawa and Whangarei.

Top Swimmer Ciara Smith

Last July Ciara competed at the Youth Commonwealth Games in the Bahamas, bringing home two silver medals and a bronze. In August she was selected for the High Performance Sport NZ Pathway

to Podium Programme. In September 2017 she was again part of the New Zealand team sent to Canberra for the Australian State Teams Short Course Championships. She was co-captain of the team and awarded the top 15-16 year female in the team after the event. At the competition she broke the NZ record for 15-16 year olds in 100m breast. In October she followed that up with breaking the national open and age group records in 200m breast and also broke her own national age group record in 100m breast. At the Northland ASB Sports awards in October she was awarded the overall Sportswoman of the Year title. At the 2017 Auckland Age Group Championships in December she broke the NZ 17 year age group 50m breast record.

In March, Ciara and teammate Annabell Simpson were both named in the New Zealand team to compete at the Oceania Championships in Papua New Guinea in late June. However, due to timing issues the swimmers pulled out of the team as they both wanted to perform at their best at NZ Opens in early July. At National Age Groups in April, Ciara won gold in all breaststroke distances, setting a new age group record in 50m breast. She followed this up at Opens by winning gold in 100m and 200m breast, silver in 50m breast and being named in the junior Pan Pacific Championships team travelling to Fiji, and made the Youth Olympics qualifying times. Ciara has just been named in the Swimming New Zealand silver national training squad, while teammate Annabell Simpson has made the bronze squad.

Top Technical Official Carlrine Gillespie

Carlrine Gillespie confirmed her place as one of the country's top technical officials by winning the Bill Matson Technical Official of the Year award at Swimming New Zealand's annual awards in July. Carlrine has had a busy year poolside, officiating not only at most Northland meets but has also been working on the pool deck in various roles at most national competitions. Her international officiating career took off last year when she was selected to work at the FINA World Championships in Budapest, Hungary last July, followed by officiating at the World Para Swimming Championships in Mexico. This year she and husband Ross both officiated at the Oceania Championships in Papua New Guinea in June.



Auckland Swimmers at Northland Age Group Championships

Competition at the biggest event on the Northland calendar, the Northland Age Group Championships held in Dargaville in January, was boosted by the participation of contingents of swimmers from Auckland clubs Coast and Roskill. The young Northland swimmers enjoy seeing these older swimmers competing and it gives our small number of older swimmers some great competition. Coast's top swimmers stayed on after the championships for a training camp based at the Dargaville pool. Dargaville Club swimmers were invited to watch a training session and had the chance to talk to coach Steven Kent and Olympian Helena Gasson, who was training for April's Commonwealth Games – a valuable chance to see top level swimmers in action and meet one of the country's top swimmers. Steven talked to them about the importance of honing their skills, practising fast starts and turns and being dedicated to their training, as well as having fun and working and supporting each other as a team. He also emphasised that coming from a small town should not hinder their dreams of becoming top level sportspeople.

This will be my final report as the Chair of the Swimming Northland Board.

There have been some trying times in this position but the successes far outweigh this & overall as a volunteer, it is all about the swimmer(s) in our region.

As you will read in the following reports, there is much to celebrate & I must mention the outstanding achievements that continue for Ciara Smith & her coach, Monica Cooper from the Northwave club. Ciara is a dedicated, hard working swimmer who is a great ambassador for Swimming Northland. We wish her all the very best for the future & I am sure we will see her continually achieve & excel.

Over this past season the Board has finalised the Board Manual & Policies, which we will continue to review & add to. Many thanks to our Vice Chair Louise Wickham, who has done an outstanding job in setting up these documents to be ratified by the Board.

The Board has also set up a four year Annual Plan, which will be a 'living document' that leads our governance agenda at meetings & also reflect our strategic planning.

There were opportunities during the season for board members to attend governance workshops, provided by Sport Northland, which were well received by those that attended.

Sport Northland also convenes a Northland Sports Governance Forum twice a year for the Chairs of sport in Northland to attend & share ideas, of which I was a participant.

The Board decided this season to put out the stakeholder survey at the beginning & the end of the season to provide a better insight in to what may or may not have worked. It also highlighted if the members knowledge of swimming in Northland had improved or not.

The responses to the survey increased & the Board received valuable feedback from a range of members. This in turn was discussed at the forum held at the Age Group Champs.

The Board has been trying to move forward in terms of technology with the purchase of tablets so that these may be used by the board members for storing of information (ie manual & policies, constitution, board minutes etc...) & to help with the environment re printing of many pages of information each month for meetings. It also enables board members to be 'present' at meetings via 'zoom' when they are unable to attend in person.

Following on from this, with the lead taken by board member Jess Rule, of 'cloud' basing all of Swimming Northland's documents & archives.

There were some changes to the Board over the season with Celia Honiss & Chris Martin no longer on the board & the two casual vacancies filled by Matt White & Jo Hodson. Thank you to Celia & Chris for your time on the Board & to Matt & Jo for taking the step forward to fill these vacancies.

To all our Swimming Northland management committee members (as named in this annual report) for Events, Funding, Publicity & Technical, a huge thank you for volunteering your time.

Many, many thanks & appreciation once again to Rachel Bray (Administrator) & Sharon Smith (Treasurer) for the outstanding job you have done this season & for your continued support.

Also to my fellow board members Louise Wickham, Jess Rule & Kim McCahon, thank you so much for the dedication you have given to Swimming Northland & the support you have given me as your Chair.

SWIMMING NORTHLAND EVENTS COMMITTEE REPORT

This year's calendar was compiled with club feedback requesting that we have approximately one carnival per month through the winter months, to ensure good numbers attend every carnival. With this in mind, a calendar was compiled and by the time all clubs wishing to hold an event had dates allocated, and national events were entered, SN was left with far less carnivals to hold compared to the previous season. The events committee organised and ran the Presentation Carnival in July, Long Distance Champs in December, Age Groups in January and Rising Stars in March.

The Presentation Carnival was held at Whangarei Pool and was very well supported for the first event of the new season. The presentations were held first in the spectator area, which worked well. We were also able to use the time pads which the swimmers enjoyed. We had 94 swimmers and 378 entries, so an average of 4 events per swimmer. This carnival operated at a profit.

Long Distance Champs scheduled for December but was cancelled due to lack of entries. One issue was this year's event being scheduled for the same date as the Paihia Ocean Swim. Further attempts were made to hold LD later in the season, but there was really no suitable date available, so the meet was unfortunately abandoned. For the 17-18 season, we have put in a provision to only hire the lanes we need so that we can cater for lower entries, although we are hopeful that clubs will once again support this event.

The Douglas Logging Northland Age Groups were held in late January. Once again, we were lucky to have 38 visitors from 3 clubs join the event which gave our Northland swimmers good competition. We had 162 total swimmers with 1126 entries, an average of 7 events per swimmer. The weather was fairly good all weekend which added to the event. A few small changes were made in the organisation which we felt added to the smooth running of the weekend. The committee shared the jobs, so that the pre-preparation was not too much of a burden on a few. This event was also profitable.

The committee assisted Sport Northland with the running of Northland Secondary Swimming Champs in February – basically Sport Northland gather entries and the events committee runs the day. We are lucky that all our qualified technical officials support this day.

The final event on the calendar was Rising Stars in March. This was well supported despite a few travelling complications due to the closure of Lemons Hill. We had 89 swimmers with 669 entries, an average of almost eight swims per person. It was felt that the entry criteria for this year did target the correct swimmers, but there was concern that there were swimmers present who had swum in no other club carnivals during the season. The committee will be addressing this issue for the upcoming season, as it is a championship meet for those who have failed to gain a national qualification. Rising Stars operated at a small profit, as it had no funding and the costs of medals and ribbons.

In addition to the planned meets, SN ran 3 time trials throughout the season, targeting first junior festival swimmers and then Div 2 qualifiers in two Friday night events at Whangarei Pool which were monetarily neutral. The NAGS swimmers had a time trial opportunity in conjunction with Rising Stars. All three of these events were well received by the clubs.

The Events Committee supported eight carnivals throughout the season, run by seven different clubs. All were considered successes by the organizing clubs.

Finally, as each event has taken place during this season, we have developed a good set of guidelines for what needs to be done prior to the event, so that it is easier to track that everything is sorted. This base "Jobs to Do" guide will help immensely in future years.

During the season, two of the committee resigned – Denis Garner and Huria Heperi. Thank you to them for their contribution over the past 2 seasons.

At our "Season Conclusion" meeting held at Rising Stars: Sam Simons, Karly Smith and Jodi Stoddart joined Sharon Carroll and Beth Finer on the committee. Dawn Dutton also took over the medals/ribbons and Kylie Douglas took over the uniforms.



SWIMMING NORTHLAND TECHNICAL COMMITTEE REPORT

Northland continues to hold its own, perhaps even leading the field, with training swimming technical officials. We continue to focus on training officials throughout the season and brought several in as qualified timekeepers, turn inspectors, judges of stroke and starter, as well as starting several trainees working towards poolside positions. At Northland Age Group champs, David Finer qualified as regional starter, Sian Williams as national IOT, Jo Hodson as national IOT and regional JOS, Michelle Hull as national IOT and regional JOS and all current referees were reassessed by our regional technical advisor Ross Bragg. Other newly qualified IOTs in the past season include Dawn Dutton, Carol Ludbrook, Matt White, Sandro Schuetze and Ina Schuetze. The focus on training will continue this season, and we encourage all clubs to put forward suitable people to train. In the coming season, we'll be looking to step some of our experienced IOTs up to JOS and then to start on referee or starter training.

Northland officials continue to help at local, area and regional school swimming sports and the ASB Northland Secondary School Championships. Schools and Sport Northland appreciate the help from our officials.

Celia Honiss assisted with running Special Olympics swimming events during the season, along with officials and volunteer helpers.

Many thanks to Beth Finer, who continues to run our control room/admin team with any helpers she can muster, often assisted by Gavin Carroll, Karley Smith, Sam Simons and Kyran Gillespie.

Special recognition must go to Carlrine Gillespie who won the Northland Conbrio Sporting Official of the Year award and also the Swimming New Zealand Bill Matson Technical Official of the Year Award, capping off a year of international appointments since being appointed to the FINA official list for swimming last year. Carlrine officiated the World Para Swimming Championships in Mexico in December, the FINA World Championships in Budapest, Hungary in July and both she and Ross Gillespie officiated at the Oceania Championships in Papua New Guinea in June. We are fortunate to have people of Carlrine and Ross's calibre to assist with training our technical officials.

SUMMARY OF THE MEET

Northland's swimmers made their presence felt at last week's National Age Group Championships at the Sir Owen G Glenn National Aquatics Centre in Auckland where they spent five days competing with around 700 of the country's top age group swimmers. Between them, the 18 Northlanders picked up seven medals and broke several Northland records – and one New Zealand Age Group record.

Top performer was Northwave's Ciara Smith (17). She won gold in all three breaststroke distances and placed fifth in both the 200m IM and 400m IM. She set a new New Zealand Age Group record in 50m breast with a time of 32.21 seconds, breaking her own record of 32.27 set last December. She set new Northland Open long course records in all five of her events – as well as breaking her own 50m record, she claimed the 100m and 200m, records that were set by Northwave's Ashley Masters in 2008. She took seven seconds off the time she set last March for the 16-17-year 400m IM and went a second under the 200m IM open record set by the Bay of Islands' Carla Marsh in 2011.

Ciara's teammate Annabelle Simpson (17) medalled in all three of her backstroke events, winning silver in 100m and 200m and bronze in 50m. She took out the 17-year age group long course record for 50m back set in 2000 by Kamo's Kushla Chapman and set new Northland Open long course records in all three strokes, two of them her own records and one set by clubmate Hayley McIntosh in 200m backstroke in 2016.

Young Northwave swimmer Tyler Jepsen (13) made his mark on the competition, taking silver in 200m back and in 400m free setting a new time for the Northland long course age group record, set by Bay of Islands' Jeremy Elliot in 2015. Tyler placed 5th in 400m free, 8th in 100m back and 200m free.

Other Northland Age Group long course record breakers included Bay of Islands' Emilia Finer (13) who took 15-plus seconds off her time to claim the 800m free time set by Northwave's Ellie Eastwood in 2013; and set a new time in 12-13-year girls 200m fly. Emilia made finals in four of her eight events, placing 4th in 200m fly and 800m free, 7th in 400m free and 8th in 100m fly. Bream Bay's Paul Linton (17) went under the 100m backstroke time set by Matthew Gordon in 2015.

Other top 10 placegetters at National Age Group Championships were Nellie Clark (14, Northwave) 5th in 100m breast; Madeline Whittam (14, Northwave): 5th 200m breast, 7th 50m breast, 8th 100m breast.

SUMMARY OF THE MEET

It has been a huge week in the pool for our region's top swimmers as they competed against more than 300 of the country's best plus a smattering of internationals at the 2018 NZ Open Championships in Auckland from 2-6 July.

Ciara Smith (17) was Northland's top performer winning gold in both 100m and 200m breaststroke and silver in 50m breaststroke. Ciara has made the NZ team competing at the Junior Pan-Pacific Championships in Fiji next month, after qualifying in 100m breaststroke. Bream Bay's Paul Linton (17) made a top 20 finish in 50m back. Also swimming at NZ Opens were Northwave's Nellie Clark and Madeline Whittam (both 14).

This is an area that we always struggle in even though we do take advantage of the young people who need to do community service as part of their DOE commitment. Thank you to the coaches who gave up their time to enable this program to happen. The \$20 gift voucher we give you seems minimal when one considers the efforts that you put in for the swimmers.

We have also been fortunate to have a group of parents who came on board to enable the more competent swimmers to undertake stroke correction and prepare for competition. We now have an enthusiastic committee to take the club forward. Unfortunately, because they were so good at their job, several of our better swimmers took advantage of the Rural Travel fund offered by the Kaipara District council. The \$600 received from them enabled parents to car pool to attend swimming lessons in Bream Bay. The outcome however, while great for the swimmers has meant that these people have now joined the Bream Bay club as they want to become more competitive (and ours is only a cold water pool with a limited time it can be used.)

Thank you also to the Otamatea High School for their support of our club by allowing us to use the pool. We also had the competent support of Ellen Snelling in coaching the youngsters in the finer points of their stroke. We are fortunate that both our local schools have not only kept their pools open but they have also made the pools accessible to us as we need them. Thank you also to Karen Smales who has provided mentoring for the people who have needed it in the club.



As Northwave heads in to its 20th year we again celebrate the success of our swimmers over the past season. From our very junior swimmers through to our NZ representatives everyone has had a season full of competing and having fun together as a squad.

Ciara Smith had a particularly busy season training, travelling and competing at National and International events. One highlight was Ciara winning Bronze in the 100m Breaststroke and Silver in the NZ team Medley Relay at the Commonwealth Youth Games in the Bahamas. At the Australian National State Championships Ciara won the 100m Breaststroke and broke the NZ Age Record time. She placed second in the 50m and 200m Breaststroke events. A week later at the NZ Short Course National Championships Ciara broke her own NZ record again in the heat of the 100m Breaststroke and again in the final, Age Group Gold and Open Bronze. Also AG Silver, Open Bronze 50m Breaststroke. Her most notable performance at NZSC was to break the NZ Open Women's 200m Breaststroke record to win Gold. This was also a NZ Age Group record.

At the Auckland Championships meet in December 2017 Ciara broke the 17yr Girls NZ Age Group record in the final of the 50m Breaststroke. In April 2018 Ciara won Gold in the 50m, 100m and 200m Breaststroke events for 17-18yr Girls and broke her NZ Age record in the 50m Breaststroke with a time of 32:21.

Over the season Ciara broke a NZ Open Record and seven NZ Age Group records. Ciara was also selected as a High Performance Pathway to Podium athlete. Outstanding results for Ciara and coach Monica.

It must be noted that if the SNZ High Performance Tokyo 2020 Squad was still in place Ciara Smith would have been included as her time of 1.09:83 was within the NZ HP selection time.

Annabell Simpson and Madeline Whittam also won medals at NZSC. Annabell Bronze 200m Backstroke, Madeline Silver, 100m Breaststroke and 200m Breaststroke. Annabell also placed 4th in her 50m and 200m Backstroke events.

Ciara Smith and Annabell Simpson are SNZ Development targeted swimmers.

NAGs 2018 team: Ciara Smith 17yrs, Annabell Simpson 17yrs, Madeline Whittam 14yrs, Nellie Clark 14yrs, Nathalie Hull 14yrs, Tyler Jepsen 13yrs, Quin Walden 13yrs, (Jeremy Elliot 16yrs DNA). Our team at 2018 NAGs had a successful meet with everyone producing PB performances. In addition to Ciara's results Annabell won Silver medals in the 100m and 200m Backstroke and Bronze in the 50m Backstroke.

Tyler won Silver in the 13yr Boys 200m Backstroke, missed a Bronze medal in the 400m Free by :06" to take 4th with a big PB and broke the Northland AG record. Nellie also produced two very big PB's in the heat and final of the 14yr Girls 100m Breaststroke to place 5th and qualify for NZ Opens.

Madeline swam a very strong race in the final of the 200m Breaststroke to PB and add that event for NZ Opens. Quin pushed hard and achieved PB's in all five events he entered and was first reserve in three races.

Overall our Northwave team of seven gained three Gold, three Silver and one Bronze Medal. To add to that a further nine finals with five of those top five finishes.

1. Statement of Accounting Policies

Reporting Entity

These are the financial statements of NORTHLAND SWIMMING ASSOCIATION (INC), a registered body under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with section 23 of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The principal activity of the association is swimming promotion.

Measurement Base

The measurement basis adopted in the preparation of these financial statements is historic cost.

Differential Report

These financial statements are a general-purpose report, which has been prepared in accordance with the Framework of Differential Reporting. The entity has taken advantage of all exemptions available to it with the exception that the statements have been prepared exclusive of GST. The entity has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not for Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Statement of Financial Performance are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Statement of Financial Performance is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

2. Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in Accounting Policies. All policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used in previous years. An auditor was appointed in terms of Section 21 of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.

3. Fixed Assets and Depreciation

All fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation.

Depreciation of the assets has been calculated at the maximum rates permitted by the Income Tax Act 2007. The entity has the following asset classes:

Plant & Equipment. 13% - 60% Diminishing Value

4. Goods and Services Tax

These financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis with the exception of Accounts Receivable and Accounts Payable. All assets and liabilities have been stated exclusive of GST.

5. Taxation

No Income Tax liability has been provided for in the financial statements as the entity, being an amateur sports promoter, is exempt from all income tax pursuant to section CW 46 of the Income Tax Act 2007.

6. Accounts Receivable

Receivables are stated at their estimated realisable value. Bad debts are written off in the year in which they are identified.

7. Audit

These financial statements have been subject to audit, please refer to Auditor's Report.

8. Contingent Liabilities

There were no contingent liabilities for three years. The was only one capital commitment in 2016.
