### SPORT NORTHLAND RELATIONSHIP MANAGER'S REPORT

This last 12 months for the Swimming Northland board has been a time of transition from management committee to board and establishing how the board will operate under this new structure. It has taken some time as the new board of four elected members and two temporary members (myself and Kim McCahon) were still undertaking the duties and function of the former management committee, however with a reduced number of supporting cast to undertake all the necessary activities which put pressure on the board to keep things ticking over while at the same time trying to operate as a board and govern.

A board's role is "to ensure the organisation is well managed, but not to do the managing" (Sport NZ Nine Steps to Effective Governance). In larger Regional Sports Organisations (RSO) paid staff would normally perform the managing role however in smaller volunteer RSOs the board is quite often left trying to perform the functions of managing and governing.

The board took action in May to establish subcommittees to perform the 'managing' function to alleviate the pressure and give the board space to move in to more of a governing function. The transition over the last couple of months has been a good exercise in defining board/subcommittee boundaries which will probably continue for a few more months to come as subcommittees work through the annual work to be performed. Thank you to all those people that put their hand up to sit on a subcommittee and volunteer your time to keeping swimming functioning at a regional level.

The board will now start to focus on restructuring meetings to be more governance focused, and look at governance issues e.g. health and safety, finances, strategic plan etc to fulfil the current strategic plan goals. The current strategic plan will end in July 2017 where the board will look to re-set it for the next 3 years, which will give the board an exciting opportunity in its new function to look forward and set the direction for Swimming Northland in the years to come.

I would like to say thank you to all the current Swimming Northland board members for the time and dedication put in to Swimming Northland and ultimately the betterment of swimming in Northland. There are a lot of unseen hours put in behind the scenes and equal amounts of passion for the sport.

### NORTHLAND TEAM MANAGER'S REPORT 2015 NEW ZEALAND SHORT COURSE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Venue: Sir Owen Glenn National Aquatic Centre, Auckland

**Date:** 11-15 August 2015

The Northland swimming team produced some outstanding results at the 2015 NZ Short Course Champs at the new Sir Owen Glenn National Aquatic Centre in Auckland recently, with eight swimmers bringing home an amazing 20 national medals between them, equalling last year's total medal haul. More medals were only a touch away, with another seven 4<sup>th</sup> placings being recorded.

The Northwave club was the most Northland successful club, with seven swimmers winning a total of 18 medals between them, which saw them placed 13<sup>th</sup> on the club points table out of over 80 teams competing in the championships.

The star Northlander was undoubtedly Northwave's Callum Prime, who brought home an incredible 8 national medals. Prime, who is a member of the Educare Northland Sports Talent Hub, lived up to his rankings, winning gold in the boys 15 years 200m and 400m individual medley and the 200m backstroke. He also won silver medals in the 100m backstroke and the 100m freestyle, as well as bronze medals in the 100m individual medley, the 50m backstroke and the 50m freestyle.

Prime has picked up where he left off in 2014/15 season, where he won 12 national medals across both the short and long course formats.

Another seven Northlanders won national medals, with the Northwave trio of Ciara Smith, Ellie Eastwood and Hayley McIntosh, as well as Bream Bay's Paul Linton, all securing multiple medals.

In the girls 14 years age group, Smith secured a gold medal in the 100m breaststroke, a silver medal in the 200m breaststroke and a bronze in the 50m breaststroke.

Eastwood won 2 silver medals, in the girls 15 years 100m and the 200m breaststroke, while McIntosh won a silver in the 400m freestyle and a bronze in the 200m backstroke in the girls 16 years age group.

Both McIntosh and Eastwood came close to further medals, with McIntosh 4<sup>th</sup> in both the 200m and 800m freestyle and Eastwood 4<sup>th</sup> in the 400m individual medley.

Eastwood also made the women's Open final for the 400m individual medley, placing her amongst the top open swimmers across the country for this event.

Linton won silver medals in the 50m and 100m backstroke in the boys 14 years age group and also placed 6<sup>th</sup> in the 200m backstroke.

Single national medals were won by the Northwave trio of Annabell Simpson (silver in the girls 14 years 200m backstroke), Jeremy Elliott (bronze in the boys 14 years 50m butterfly) and Mia Gordon (bronze in the girls 13 years 50m breaststroke).

All three were also very close to more medals, with Simpson  $4^{th}$  in the 50m and 100m backstroke, Elliott  $4^{th}$  in the 200m freestyle and Gordon  $4^{th}$  in the 200m breaststroke and  $5^{th}$  in the 50m breaststroke.

Top five placings went to the Bream Bay duo of Kieran Swords (4<sup>th</sup> in the boys 16 years 50m butterfly) and Isabelle Paton (4<sup>th</sup> in the girls 16 years 200m breaststroke), while Josh Young (Northwave) and Conor Swords (Bream Bay) both recorded top ten finishes.

The other Northlanders to compete in the champs were Hayley Donovan (Whangarei) and Bream Bay's Dylan Sims and Rose Linton.

Over 50 Northland age group and Open records were broken during the championships, with Prime securing half of these. Prime (8), McIntosh (3), Eastwood (2) and Simpson (1) all broke Northland Open records.

Eastwood, Simpson, Smith and Linton were all selected to attend the 2015 NZ Age Group Development Camp in October, where they will join Prime, McIntosh, Paton and Elliott, who were all selected following the NZ Age Group (Long Course) Championships earlier this year.

Finally, a really big thank you to coach Monica Cooper, the club team managers and all the parents and supporters for their help and support during the week.

This year has been a true roller coaster ride for our club. We started the season without a coach, with committed parents poolside keeping squad training going. Our dedicated committee sifted through coaching CV's, interviewed applicants and then hired Alex Bennett as our new head coach.

Alex stresses technique as a fundamental cornerstone, so our swimmers went back to basics when he arrived in September and had their strokes rebuilt with a real emphasis on future achievement. To that end, Alex did not focus too greatly on this year's national events, as he realised his swimmers did not have a long enough time frame to be optimally prepared. Still, our determined swimmers managed to do well.

Neve Clapton was our sole representative at NZ Opens, competing in the 50m backstroke at this pinnacle event.

While we had no representatives at National Age Groups this year, three swimmers went to Division 2 in Invercargill. Samantha Turner achieved a gold relay medal and two individual bronze medals from her four individual races plus Northland relays. Archie White swam five individual races and achieved a silver individual medal in the 50 breast and a bronze relay medal as well. Giorgia Davies, a late qualifier, did well in her two races.

At a junior level, Emilia Finer competed in five races at New Zealand Junior Championships at the new Millennium Centre in Auckland, and Maia Williams also competed with a significant personal best in her 50m butterfly race.

Emilia was the only swimmer in our club to break a Northland record this year: the 11 and under girls 1500m long course race record at Swimming Northland's Long Distance Championships, an admirable achievement as she was our sole team representative because training emphasis at that time in our truncated coaching season was on the 50's and 100's. At a club level, we also had a tumultuous year as the season got off to a late start and a pool pump problem forced the nightmarish reschedule of our Spring Championships. Because of the altered calendar this season, our annual Lions Relay was swum at Manaia Club's carnival (thank you Manaia). We retained the trophy, but only because of some fortuitous disqualifications! Our End of Season Carnival, which incorporated our Club Championships, thankfully ran very smoothly.

Our difficult times have seen the club pull together and we are extremely grateful for everyone's support during this year.

Special thanks to Sammy Turner for teaching learn to swim throughout the year, and to Neve Clapton who kept the young squads swimming throughout our time without a coach. Finally, the club expresses its sincere appreciation to our remarkable head coach Alex Bennett. We realize transitioning to our club has been difficult at times, but he has already made a huge difference in our swimmers. We have no doubt that our club is on the right track for future achievement.

We can only hope that we have a stable upcoming year where we will see our swimmers working hard, having fun and striving to achieve their own individual goals. Beth Banks Finer

# CLUB PRESIDENT'S REPORT MAUNGATUROTO SWIMMING CLUB

Once again we are very grateful for the support of both Maungaturoto Primary School and Otamatea High School for providing us with facilities that we can use. Unfortuntately, because both are cold water pools, we struggle to keep competitive swimmers who need to be able to train over a much longer period so head to heated pools north and south of us.

For this reason we focus on providing a Swimsafe program for the younger swimmers. This has been very successful over the years but is dependent on people willing to become coaches. This year we decided that for anyone who was willing to coach for swimsafe that we would pay for the cost of the course. While we had several applicants we only had one person take up this offer. We have also been able to purchase new equipment to have at the primary school. The equipment we own at both schools is for the use of both the club and the school. Our parents also assist both schools when it comes to the running of their swimming championship events.

We look forward to a new season that will offer new opportunities and hopefully we will be able to reinstate our Club night this year. # CLUB PRESIDENT'S REPORT NORTHWAVE SWIMMING CLUB

Each season I reflect on the achievements of our Northwave Club swimmers and each season the list of achievements grows. I would like to pay tribute to our coach Monica for the standard of Excellence she sets within her squad and for the energy and passion she gives to provide the platform for success for her swimmers.

Without this level of guidance and expertise our swimmers would not be where they are.

Within the squad our swimmers raised the bar to produce better individual performances. Hayley, Northland Swimmer of the Year, Northwave Top Northland Club and Monica Northland Coach of the Year.

At the NZ Short Course Championships our team of 7 won 18 Medals - 4 Gold, 7 silver and 7 Bronze with a high percentage of PB performances. This was a NZ Team Selection Meet and Hayley McIntosh and Callum Prime were selected for the NZ team to compete at the Australian National State Team Championships. In Canberra Callum was the only NZ team member to place 1st in an event, plus Callum gained other placings. Both Hayley and Callum produced excellent PB's and gained very valuable experience.

Hayley McIntosh, Ciara Smith, Annabell, Simpson, Ellie Eastwood, Jeremy Elliot, Callum Prime and Coach Monica were all invited to attend the SNZ National Age Camp held the Owen Glenn HPC in October.

Hayley McIntosh, Callum Prime, Ellie Eastwood and Monica (selected as Team Manager/Coach but DNA) were all selected for the Harlequins Zonal team. Hayley won the Open 400m Free and placed 2nd in the Open 800m Free with the Harlequins team again winning top team.

In April 2016 Hayley travelled to Adelaide as a member of the NZ Team to compete at the Australian Age Championships gaining a Silver medal in the 16yr Girls 800m Free and missed the bronze in the 400m Free by a fraction of a second and sixth placing in the 200m Free. All PBs and after swimming under the Junior Pan Pac's qualifying standards at Auckland Champs and Zonal Hayley took a further 8 seconds off the 800m and 400m QT.'s. Hayley's performances were of such a high standard that she and Monica have been invited into the High Performance 2020 Podium at Tokyo National Squad.

At the same time Matthew Gordon, Ciara Smith, Annabell Simpson and Mia Gordon were all competing at NZ Opens. Ciara won a Silver medal in the Women's 50m Breaststroke and Bronze in the 100m Breaststroke. Ciara's time was only :2 off the NZ AG record in the 50m Breaststroke. This is the first time a female swimmer representing Northland has won a Open medal since another Northwave swimmer Kushla Chapman in the 90's.

Ciara also placed 10th in the A Final if the 200m Breaststroke. Annabell made 3 Finals, 200m Backstroke A Final 10th, 100 Backstroke B Final 3rd, Women's 50m Backstroke B Final 4th. Matthew Gordon Men's 200m IM B Final 10th. Mia competed in the Women's 50 and 100m Breaststroke with a a PB in the 100m Breaststroke.

At National Age Championships our team continued to strive for improved times.

#### **Statement of Accounting Policies**

#### Reporting Entity

These are the financial statements of NORTHLAND SWIMMING ASSOCIATION (INC), a registered body under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with section 23 of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The principal activity of the association is swimming promotion.

#### Measurement Base

The measurement basis adopted in the preparation of these financial statements is historic cost.

#### Differential Reporting

The entity qualifies for differential reporting exemptions as it is not publicly accountable and does not come within the definition of a large entity. The entity has taken advantage of all exemptions available to it with the exception that the statements have been prepared exclusive of GST.

#### Specific Accounting Policies

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement if financial performance and financial position have been applied.

#### Good and Services Tax

These statements have been prepared exclusive of GST. All assets and liabilities have been stated exclusive of GST with the exception of accounts receivable and accounts payable, which have been stated inclusive of GST.

#### Fixed Assets

The laptop and all assets purchased since April 1999 are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. All other fixed assets were introduced at their 30 April 1999 market value and have been depreciated since that date.

#### Depreciation

Fixed assets have been depreciated at rates, which reflect their estimated useful lives as follows:

Plant and Equipment 11.4% - 60DV

#### Accounts Receivable

Accounts receivable are stated at estimated realizable value. Amounts not considered recoverable have been written off during the year.

#### **Taxation**

No income tax liability has been provided for in the financial statements as the entity, being an amateur sports promoter, is exempt from all income tax pursuant to section CW 46 of the Income Tax Act 2007.

#### Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no significant changes in accounting policies. All accounting policies have remained the same.

#### **Operating Revenue**

The total revenue for the year was \$63,150. Previous full year's revenue was \$85,775.
