## SPORT NORTHLAND RELATIONSHIP MANAGER'S REPORT

---

Through Sport Northland's targeted sport focus I have been working with Swimming Northland as one of our regionally prioritised sports since 2011. My main role has been to advise and support the Swimming Northland management committee to build their capability to "Lead and Support Swimming" in the region. I would like to thank all the committee members who have volunteered their time to Swimming Northland and what you do for the sport in the Northland region. Volunteers are the heart of any sport.

Over the past 12 months there have been four key projects we have worked on:

**Renewed Strategic Plan** – The latest 2014–2017 Swimming Northland Strategic Plan was renewed last year and adopted just prior to the 2014 AGM. This was mainly an update of the 2011–2014 Strategic Plan which was a complete redevelopment. The 2014-2017 Strategic Plan will be the guiding document for Swimming Northland and what they are aiming to achieve.

**Transition from Management Committee to Board Structure** – At the 2014 AGM, Swimming Northland adopted the new regional constitution that Swimming NZ issued. As part of adopting this new constitution, Swimming Northland was required to transition from a management committee to a board over the next 12 months. The new board structure will take place at the 2015 AGM followed several weeks later by the election of two independent board members to make up the required six board members. The Board will act in more of a governance role where by governance is roughly defined as below (taken from the Sport NZ Nine Steps to Effective Governance resource):

"Governance is the process by which the board...

- ensures the organisation complies with all legal and constitutional requirements;
- sets strategic direction and priorities;
- sets high-level policies and management performance expectations;
- characterises and oversees the management of risk; and
- monitors and evaluates organisational performance;

...in order to exercise its accountability to the organisation and its owners".

**Regional Sports Organisation Coaching Fund** – Sport Northland have supported Swimming Northland to secure some funding to put on several subsidised coaching courses to upskill coaches in the region. To date the AUSTSWIM Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety, AUSTSWIM Towards Competitive Strokes courses and Breaststroke Clinic have been run. Another coaching clinic focusing swimmer development will be run around October.

**Annual Stakeholder Survey** – For the past three years, Sport Northland has conducted the annual stakeholder survey for Swimming Northland. The introduction of this survey was an action from the strategic plan for Swimming Northland to get a gauge from their clubs and members on whether they understood what Swimming Northland's role was, what they thought they could be doing better and what they would like to see in the future. Unfortunately the response from clubs has been poor however some valuable feedback has come in via the returns that were received.

The main thread of feedback was around Swimming Northland developing a clear pathway for swimmers and developing regional squad/s with a lead coach to encourage the up and coming swimmers and support the high performing swimmers. The new Swimming Northland board will look at this initiative for the future.

The Northland swimming team produced some outstanding results, bringing home 20 national medals between them, which was two more than last year's amazing effort at the same championships.

The star was Northwave's 14 year old Callum Prime, who brought home an incredible nine national medals. Callum lived up to his rankings, winning gold in the 14 years 100m and 200m backstroke and the 400m individual medley. He won silver medals in the 50m backstroke, the 100m and 200m freestyle, and the 200m individual medley, as well as bronze medals in the 100m individual medley and the 400m freestyle. He also won many of the 13/14 years night finals in his events.

Prime has picked up where he left off in 2013/14 season, where he won 12 national medals across both the short and long course formats.

Bay of Island's Daniel Gaulofa, swimming in the Athlete with a Disability category, has also picked up where he left off last season, winning 6 national medals. Gaulofa, fresh back from representing NZ in the Junior Para Pan Pacific Championships, won gold in the 100m breaststroke and silvers in the 100m backstroke and the 400m freestyle. He also brought home bronze medals in the 50m freestyle, the 100m butterfly and the 200 individual medley.

The other Northlanders to secure national medals were the Northwave trio of Ciara Smith, Ellie Eastwood and Hayley McIntosh.

Smith won all her medals in the breaststroke events, securing silver in the 13 years 200m breaststroke and bronze medals in the 50m and 100m events. Eastwood won bronze in the 14 years 200m breaststroke event, and also placed 9<sup>th</sup> in both the 200m and 400m individual medleys and 10<sup>th</sup> in the 100m breaststroke. McIntosh secured her bronze in the 15 years 200m backstroke, and also placed 5<sup>th</sup> in the 200m and 400m freestyle, 7<sup>th</sup> in the 100m backstroke and 8<sup>th</sup> in the 800m freestyle.

Both Eastwood and McIntosh also won finals on the penultimate night of competition – Eastwood in the 13/14 years 400m individual medley and McIntosh in the 15/16 years 200m backstroke.

McIntosh and Smith were both selected to attend the NZ Age Group Development Camp, where they will join Prime, Eastwood, Matthew Gordon and Madeline Gordon, who were all selected following the NZ Age Group (Long Course) Championships earlier this year.

## TEAM MANAGER'S REPORT NEW ZEALAND AGE GROUPS 2015

---

**Venue:** Wellington Regional Aquatic Centre, Wellington

**Date:** 5-9 May 2015

The Northland swimming team came away from the 2015 national age group champs with a swag of medals and top five finishes, making it one of the most successful all round performances from a Northland swimming team.

Ten swimmers won a total of 14 medals in their age groups, with Educare Northland Sports Talent Hub members Callum Prime and Hayley McIntosh (both from Northwave) leading the way with three medals each. Another five swimmers recorded top five finishes, resulting in over half the Northland team of 27 finishing in the top five of at least one event.

Prime (15) placed in the top five in all of his seven events, winning silver medals in the 50m freestyle, the 200m backstroke and the 200m individual medley, placing 4<sup>th</sup> in the 400m individual medley, the 100m backstroke and the 100m freestyle, and 5<sup>th</sup> in the 50m backstroke.

McIntosh (16) won a silver in the 200m backstroke, bronze medals in the 200m and 400m freestyle events, and placed 5<sup>th</sup> in the 100m freestyle. Hayley was also selected by Swimming NZ to attend an Outward Bound course for being one of the top 7 females (16 years and over) who gained the highest FINA points from the championships.

Northland swimmers to finish in the top ten in their events included Northwave's Inez Wilson-Harding (3), Matthew Gordon (2) and Matigan Smith, Bream Bay's Ruby-Lee Beckham (2) and Kieran Swords (2), and Whangarei's Laura Martin (2).

An incredible 43 Northland records were broken during the championships, over half of them (22) by Callum Prime.

The most prestigious records broken were the 8 Northland long course open records broken by Northwave swimmers Callum Prime (50m freestyle x2, 100m backstroke and 200m individual medley), Matthew Gordon (50m backstroke), Hayley McIntosh (400m freestyle), Ellie Eastwood (200m breaststroke) and Ciara Smith (50m breaststroke).

Northland 15 and under long course records were broken by Callum Prime (9), Ellie Eastwood and Ciara Smith, while Northland long course age group records were broken by Callum Prime (9), Jeremy Elliott (4), Euan Sapwell (3), Mia Gordon (3), Hayley McIntosh (2), Ellie Eastwood, Ciara Smith and Matthew Gordon.

Other Northlanders to compete were Maddison Brooke, Hayley Donovan and Simon De Long (Whangarei), Dylan Sims and Emma Wickham (Bream Bay) and Josh Young (Northwave).

The Northwave team of 11 swimmers was easily the most successful Northland club, ending up 13<sup>th</sup> on the club points table out of over 80 teams competing in the championships. The majority of the teams above them on this table hail from the much larger metropolitan city areas.

The championships, open to anyone who meets the strict qualification times and with no age groupings in any of the events, attracted 258 swimmers from 53 New Zealand clubs, 9 international swimmers and also the majority of the many NZ swimmers who train overseas.

This year NZ's premier swimming championships also doubled as the qualification meet for the 2015 World Championships in Russia later in the year.

Congratulations to all the Northland swimmers for qualifying and competing at these prestigious championships, and particularly to the following for their achievements:

- Daniel Gaulofa claimed 1 gold (50m butterfly), 2 silvers (50m breaststroke and 50m backstroke) and 3 bronze (50m freestyle, 100m freestyle and 200m individual medley) in Athlete with a Disability events
- Ellie Eastwood placed 7<sup>th</sup> (6<sup>th</sup> NZer) in the 'A' final of the women's 200m breaststroke and 12<sup>th</sup> in the 400 individual medley. Ellie also broke two Northland records
- Hayley McIntosh placed 9<sup>th</sup> in the women's 800m freestyle, 12<sup>th</sup> in the 400m freestyle, 13<sup>th</sup> in the 200 backstroke (and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 'B' final) and 17<sup>th</sup> in the 200m freestyle (and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the 'B' final). Hayley also broke the four Northland records
- Ciara Smith placed 11<sup>th</sup> in the women's 50m breaststroke (and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 'B' final) and 13<sup>th</sup> in both the 100m and 200m breaststroke
- Callum Prime placed 12<sup>th</sup> in the men's 200m backstroke (and 4<sup>th</sup> in 'B' final), 13<sup>th</sup> in the 100m backstroke (and 6<sup>th</sup> in the 'B' final) and 13<sup>th</sup> in the 400m individual medley. Callum also broke nine Northland records

The overall atmosphere was great and Bay of Islands team masgots Ed the Ted and Shirley the sheep antics kept all the teams amused.

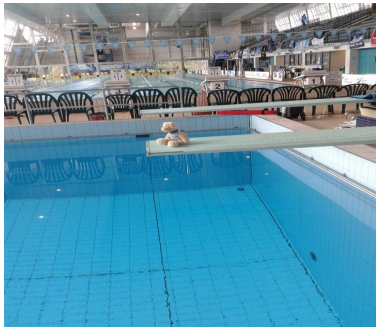
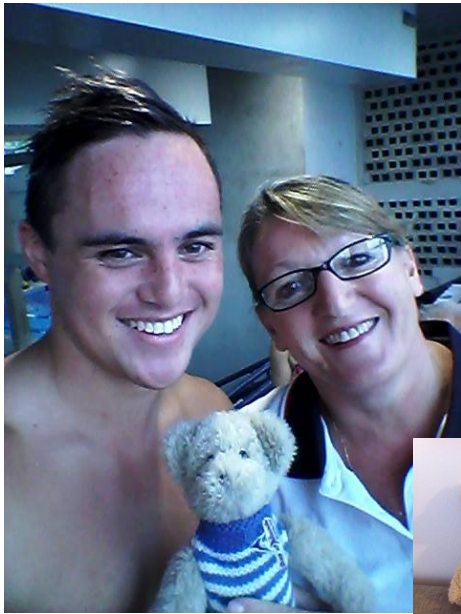

Firstly, Special Olympics BOI would like to thank Swimming Northland and the Bay of Islands Swim Club for their ongoing support of our swim team! Again we have found that our athletes are supported and welcomed by the swimming community throughout Northland.

We're right in the middle of a four-year cycle with our next National Summer Games not until late 2017 – so it's been a year of 'steady-as-she-goes'. But there have been a few highlights all the same.

### Swim Meets

Our athletes competed at two 'away' meets - Whangarei in August and Howick Pakuranga in September. There were some awesome PBs and lots of smiles at both. The HPK meet was a great time for our two groups (Kaitaia & Kawakawa to spend some time together as a Team).

### **Bay of Islands Amateur Swimming Club President's Report for 2014/2015 Season:**

At the AGM for our club last year, we talked about the great potential for the future of the club because of the increasing numbers of competitive swimmers, especially in the younger age groups. We continued to have good numbers of swimmers this year and they achieved many successes.

The year started off well with Daniel Gaulofa becoming the first Bay of Islands swimmer to compete at an unrestricted international meet, as he was a member of the team that attended the Para Pan Pacific competition in Pasadena, California.

Back in NZ, we sent a team of three (David Clarke, Jeremy Elliott and Daniel) to the Short Course Championships early in the competitive year. Later on in year, Daniel and Neve Clapton represented our club at NZ Opens, with Daniel finishing 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in his 6 para finals.

At National Age Groups, our sole representative was Jeremy Elliott, who made the finals in all 8 of his races and came home with a bronze in the 200 fly.

We had a larger contingent of swimmers at Division 2 Championships in Dunedin. Neve Clapton earned 5 individual gold, while Bryna McCondach returned with an individual medal of each colour. Ben Gaulofa made three finals, and Daniel made two. Samantha Turner completed the team and all the swimmers competed on regional relay teams, with some taking home relay medals.

In the younger age groups, we had 3 swimmers compete at NZ Juniors in Wellington. Logan Gaulofa had top 10 finishes in 7 of his 8 races, while Emilia Finer had top 10 finishes in 2 of her 8 races. Helena Sanderson completed the team.

This season, Jeremy Elliott broke multiple Northland records, while Logan Gaulofa, Emilia Finer and Archie White all set Northland race records. Our swimmers in general performed well during the season at competitions throughout Northland and in Auckland as well. We had a lot of young swimmers who continued to improve throughout the season.

At a club level, all 4 of our carnivals ran successfully, with thanks to our sponsors Flybusters, Keri Refrigeration, Mac's Prime Meats, and Kerikeri Sterndrive and Outboards. Thanks to T3 for sponsoring the skins events at our Spring Championships.



### Manaia Amateur Surf & Swim Club President's report 2014/15

*E nga reo, e nga mana, e nga karangaranga maha, tena koutou katoa.*

I've had the pleasure of representing Manaia Swim Club this year, following on from the excellent stewardship of our retiring leadership team, the Selkirks.

The 2014/15 season has been one of growth for Manaia Swim Club. As I think about our results for the season, it's clear to me that we are really great at taking emerging swimmers, improving their technique and stroke repertoire and growing competent, competitive swimmers, who love being part of Manaia Swim Club.

Manaia swimmer numbers increased about 30% by the end of the season. We now have a strong contingent in the 10-11 age group. The annual prizes for Most Improved Girl and Boy were both awarded to new swimmers this year, who have very quickly improved in ability and competitiveness over the season.

We also have a good bunch of 9&Us coming through, which should see some good little competitive swimmers over the next couple of years, if this year's primary interschool regionals was anything to go by.

We trialled a shared training approach with Kamo Swim Club, inviting their senior swimmers to train with us, in order to increase training intensity (and fun) for our own senior swimmers. This achieved improved times for all swimmers, particularly at carnivals later in the season, and culminated in the top Kamo & Manaia female swimmers attending Auckland Champs and then Division II together.

We took our collaboration with Kamo a step further and co-hosted the November Swim Fest carnival, leveraging strengths of both clubs. 33 Manaia swimmers hit the water at that meet, with quite a few taking the splash for the first time. Thanks to all whanau who assisted to help the event run smoothly and helped out with official duties. This event is our major fundraiser for the year, and is also important as an icebreaker for our new families.

I'm very proud that every single Manaia swimmer achieved personal bests, took on new strokes/events, and/or qualified for regional/national meets this year. There were many medals won at Northland Age Groups & Rising Stars. Specific congratulations go to Aimee-Leigh Scott, Leah Selkirk, Louis Poot and Matariki Moetara for qualifying for Auckland Champs; Matariki for attending Division II, winning a Silver medal for 50 Breaststroke, and Jaedyn Goodhew for attending the Northern Zone meet, winning Bronze in 100 Backstroke.

I would also like to acknowledge Dallas Wrack, who achieved National IOT status this year, and supported Manaia in an official capacity at almost every carnival in 2014. Swimming competitions cannot function without our official volunteers.

On that note, thank you to the Manaia management committee for their time and support over the past year: mainstays Dallas and Bruce, and those new committee members who took on new roles to assist with the functions of running the club: Karen for handling all our comms and facilities hire, Pip for sorting uniforms, Vanessa for managing our database, Ajit for taking care of funding, and those who fulfilled the club captain role at carnivals during the year: Vanessa, Darren, Sarah, and others.

A huge thanks to coach Ramona, who is the core strength of Manaia Swim Club, and freely gives of her time, weekends and mindspace to help our children reach their swimming goals. Thanks also to parents who support training when Ramona is unable to be there: Karen, Pip, Shelley in particular.

A big shout out to our carnival sponsors: Wrack Autos, Mill Rd Vets, Swimspiration, New World Regent and ITM; and to Oxford Trust and Pub Charities for donations which assist with our running costs and expenses.

## CLUB PRESIDENT'S REPORT NORTHWAVE SWIMMING CLUB

---

As Chairman of Northwave Swim club, Northlands High Performance swim club I have the privilege of highlighting the many successes of Northwave swimmers. Each season they perform on the national stage and this year they have collectively achieved excellent results. In fact their best ever overall team results and the most successful club team from the Northland region. Our past swimmers have only surpassed this years results by winning NZ Opens medals and NZ Representation.

Northwave swimmers take pride in being Northlands top club and our coach Monica continues to develop a skill level in our swimmers required to produce podium performances at national level.

At the 2015 National Age Group Championships Northwave swimmers were on the Podium ten times. They achieved 25 Top 5 placings, 35 individual finals and 44 Personal Best performances, with swimmers also holding their times gained three weeks earlier at NZ Opens. One notable achievement is that our swimmers competed or qualified in every event in the program in both Male and Female events at NAG's. This in a team of eleven is an achievement Monica and our swimmers can be proud of. Also placing 13th out of 77 club teams at the meet is well worth mention. Nine of the eleven team members qualified for 2016 NZ Opens ranging in age from 12yrs - 17yrs.

Ciara Smith 50m Breaststroke Silver, Annabell Simpson 50m Backstroke Silver, Madeline Gordon 50m Free Bronze, Mia Gordon 50m Breaststroke Bronze.

At NZ Opens again our swimmers rose to the occasion with all but one team member making A or B Finals. Even then Madeline Gordon's time of 27:53 in the swim off would have placed her 3rd in the B Final.

Ellie Eastwood represented Northwave in the A Final of the Women's 200m Breaststroke, Callum Prime, Matthew Gordon, Hayley McIntosh, Ciara Smith and Annabell Simpson B Finalists.

The live screening of NZ Opens on Sky highlighted Northwave's swimmers achievements seeing them compete in every Final's session throughout the meet. Northland records broken by our swimmers.

Mia Gordon 12yrs, came very close to medals at the NZ Junior Championships placing 4th, 5th and 6th in her Breaststroke events. At NAG's Mia went on to win Bronze in the 12-13yr Girls 50m Breaststroke, broke the Northland Age Group record and qualified for Opens. Kate Wickline also qualified for NZ Juniors but DNA.

Two of our swimmers who narrowly missed qualifying for NAG's Matthew Young and Caitlin Ahlers chose to not attend the Division 11 National Meet as this is not a NZ Championship meet.



Three of our club swimmers were selected to compete at the NZ Zonal Meet in the Northern Zone Harlequins team along with our Head Coach Monica who was selected as the Junior Team Coach. Callum Prime, Hayley McIntosh and Ellie Eastwood were all part of the successful Harlequins team who won the cup. This was an exciting meet to be part of with swimmers competing in up to 3 events, plus relays, selected by the coach. This meet was also televised live, more great viewing.

Hayley McIntosh 16yrs was selected by Swimming NZ to attend the Outward Bound Camp. This is quite an achievement as the team of seven Male and Female swimmers were selected by gaining the Highest FINA points at National Age Group Championships.

Earlier in the season our team at NZ Short Course Championships set a high standard for the season.

Callum Prime won Gold in 400m IM, 100m Backstroke, 200m Backstroke, silver 200m IM, 100m Free, 50m Backstroke, Bronze 200m Free, 100m IM, Ellie Eastwood Bronze 200m Breaststroke, Hayley McIntosh Bronze 200m Backstroke, Ciara Smith Bronze 100m Breaststroke plus several finalist placings for the team.

Team: Callum Prime, David van der Star, Hayley McIntosh, Ellie Eastwood, Ciara Smith, Annabell Simpson.

Throughout the season all our Northwave swimmers supported Northland swim meets and raced hard, gaining many PB's and improvement of their skills under the constant guidance of our Coach Monica.

The Northland Age Group Championships showcased their ability to successfully compete throughout a three day meet and be role models for not only Northwave's junior swimmers, but all Northland swimmers.

Our swimmers have broken numerous Northland Age Group, Junior and Open records again this season. The most prolific record breakers were Callum Prime and Hayley McIntosh. Other record breakers were Ellie Eastwood, Madeline Gordon, Ciara Smith, Mia Gordon and Matthew Gordon and David van der Star.

Hayley McIntosh and David van der Star were jointly named Swimming Northland Swimmer Year, Monica Cooper Northland Coach of the Year, David and Hayley code winners at the Northland Sports Awards with Callum a finalist.

Callum Prime and Hayley McIntosh were invited into the Northland Educare Sports Talent Hub program. This is only offered to Northlands top, fully committed athletes, so they are congratulated for this high achievement.

This season we have highlighted to Swimming Northland and to Clubs the significance of displaying Good Sportsmanship. This respect and integrity within our club has always been essential to all Northwave members whether as a swimmer, coach or parent. We can all learn very valuable life lessons from involvement in sport, none more important than Good Sportsmanship. Strong, wise leadership leads to success, this has been proven the case once again by Northwave swim club.

Our committee has done a very good job behind the scenes to ensure our swimmers have the opportunity to enjoy their chosen sport. Our parents continue to up skill in their qualifications as officials with several now nationally qualified. Mike Smith, Dean Prime, Chris McIntosh, Brent Eastwood and Celia Honiss have all officiated at SNZ meets. This involvement is imperative for the successful outcome of running our swim meets.

Special mention of thanks to our funders Pub Charity, Oxford Sports Trust and ASB Community Trust.

Monica's results over the past season have again reflected, as they do each season, what an outstanding coach she is and all Northwave members are very grateful of her unwavering commitment to produce the highest standard from her swimmers. This has most recently been acknowledged by the NZ Swim Coaches and Teachers Association. Monica has received a NZSCTA Service Award 2015 - for - 'Services to Learn To Swim and Coaching in New Zealand'. This is in recognition of the work Monica has done as a coach, leader and Educator. She is a past Chairman of Swimming Education NZ with the portfolio of Level Two and Three Level Coach Education, a past Board Member of the NZ Swimming Federation and Swimming NZ and was also a Board member of the NZ Swim Coaches and Teachers Association. She was also on the SNZ Restructure committee and the NZ Swimming Federation Delegate for NZ Water Safety. She spent several years giving voluntary service at a National and Northland level and at the same time coaching our swimmers.

**1. Statement of Accounting Policies**

**Reporting Entity**

These are the financial statements of NORTHLAND SWIMMING ASSOCIATION (INC), a registered body under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with section 23 of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The principal activity of the association is swimming promotion.

**Measurement Base**

The measurement basis adopted in the preparation of these financial statements is historic cost.

**Differential Reporting**

These financial statements are a general-purpose report, which has been prepared in accordance with the Framework of Differential Reporting. The entity qualifies for differential reporting exemptions as it is not publicly accountable and does not come within the definition of a large entity. The entity has taken advantage of all exemptions available to it with the exception that the statements have been prepared exclusive of GST.

**Specific Accounting Policies**

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of financial performance and financial position have been applied.

**Good and Services Tax**

These statements have been prepared exclusive of GST. All assets and liabilities have been stated exclusive of GST with the exception of accounts receivable and accounts payable, which have been stated inclusive of GST.

**Fixed Assets**

The laptop and all assets purchased since April 1999 are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. All other fixed assets were introduced at their 30 April 1999 market value and have been depreciated since that date.

**Depreciation**

Fixed assets have been depreciated at rates, which reflect their estimated useful lives as follows:
