## SWIMMING NORTHLAND SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

---

Swimming continues to thrive in the North despite our widespread area and the distances swimming families must travel to carnivals. Our numbers are small compared to some regions, but we continue to enjoy good support with a steady number of volunteers stepping up to train as poolside officials. We also receive good coverage in our regional daily paper's sports pages.

### **Top Swimmer**

For the third year running, Ciara Smith (18) won the title of Northland Swimmer of the Year. She is a role model for our young Northland swimmers, proving it is possible to train in Northland and perform at an elite level. Ciara trains with Whangarei-based club Northwave under the guidance of coach Monica Cooper. Last August Ciara competed at the Junior Pan Pacific Championships in Fiji, and in September she medalled in 50m, 100m and 200m breaststroke at the Victoria Open Short Course championships in Melbourne. In October at the NZ Short Course Championships, she broke the national open record in 200m breast and the 100m breaststroke national age group record. Her times propelled her into the NZ team competing at the 2018 FINA World Short Course Championships in Hangzhou, China, in December where she swam 100m and 200m breaststroke, placing 24<sup>th</sup> and 33<sup>rd</sup>. At the NZ Age Group Championships this year, Smith won gold in all three breaststroke distances and in the 400m individual medley, and silver in the 200m individual medley. She took a New Zealand Age Group record, beating Annabelle Carey's 2007 time of 2.34.31 in 200m breast with a 2.33.64 swim. At NZ Opens she won gold in both the 50m and 200m breast, breaking the NZ age group record in both events. Ciara was both Northland's ASB Secondary Schools Sports Awards and the 2018 Northland Conbrio Sports Awards swimming code female winner. She is on the long list for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games and is in Swimming New Zealand's bronze national age group squad, along with clubmate Tyler Jepsen.

### **Top Para Swimmer**

Former coach of Whangarei Swimming Club Cameron Leslie is National Para Swimming Development Coordinator, a role he took on last September. He swims under the Whangarei Club banner, and this year received a Paralympic "number" as part of the Celebration Project, along with five other Olympians. He was named Northland Disabled Sportsperson of the Year at the 2018 Conbrio Northland Sports Awards in March. At the NZ Open Championships in June, he won gold in 50m free multi-class, 200m free multi-class and 50m back multi-class and was selected for the New Zealand team competing at the 2019 World Para Swimming Championships in London this September.

### **Top Officials**

Carlisle Gillespie from Dargaville, continues her reign as Northland's top swimming official. She won the Kaipara Sports Awards official of the year title, plus the 2018 Conbrio Northland Sports awards official of the year. This year she was appointed as SNZ's technical advisor for the northern region. She has attended numerous regional and national meets, and officiated at a range of overseas events: the Oceania Championships last July in Papua New Guinea, the Para Pan Pacific Championships in Cairns last August, the Arafura Games 2019 in Darwin and this month, the 2019 Pacific Games in Samoa. Husband Ross Gillespie also officiated at the Pacific Games this month at the Open Water event and attended the 2019 Australian Open Water Championships in January. Ross was one of five FINA Open Water International Technical Officials that was appointed to the 18th FINA World Championships Open Water Swimming 2019 held in Gwangju, South Korea 13-19 July where his roles included registration, finish judge, assistant referee and referee for the final 25km event.

### **Open Water Revival**

After a break of seven years, Open Water swimming returned to Northland this season with a highly successful competition at the beautiful Kai Iwi Lakes in mid-December. Around 130 swimmers, mostly from Northland and Auckland, but also from as far afield as Hastings and Mt Maunganui, took the plunge. Ross Gillespie organised the event and was meet director. He was keen to revive the Open Water event and give swimmers an opportunity to try a different type of swimming. The entry fee was deliberately kept low to make the event affordable for families. Ruakaka Surf Life Saving Club members helped with water safety at the event while Dargaville and Te Kopuru fire brigade volunteers were on hand to help with first aid.

### **Community Support**

In March, Dargaville Swimming Club called on their club members and local community to participate in an event to honour victims of the Christchurch mosque killings and raise money for affected families. The 50x50 event saw swimmers each swim 50 laps of the Kauri Coast 50m pool. Swimmers of all ages, and several adults, took the plunge.

Our board is comprised of six board members including Jo Hodson, Louise Wickham (vice chair), Matt White, Kim McCahon and Carlrine Gillespie. Thank you all for your contributions, expertise and input that has directed, developed and grown our organisation.

A focus for the board this year has been on strategic planning and creating direction, for the future of swimming. ## SWIMMING NORTHLAND EVENTS COMMITTEE REPORT

---

This year's calendar was compiled with club feedback similar to last year requesting that we have approximately one carnival per month through the winter months, to ensure good numbers attend every carnival. With this in mind, a calendar was compiled and by the time all clubs wishing to hold an event had dates allocated, and national events were entered, The events committee organised and ran the Presentation Carnival in July, Splash Carnival in September, Open Water Swim and Long Distance Champs in December, Age Groups in January and Rising Stars in March.

The Presentation Carnival was held at Whangarei Pool and was very well supported for the first event of the new season. The presentations were held first in the spectator area, which worked well. We were also able to use the time pads which the swimmers enjoyed. We had 105 swimmers and 474 entries, which was up from the Presentation Carnival in 2017.

Swimming Northland held the September Splash Carnival on 23<sup>rd</sup> September. There were 86 Athletes entered and 454 entries. In addition to the program we had a tops and bottoms relay and spot prizes, which was well received. An Open Water Swim at Kai Iwi Lakes appeared back on the Swimming Northland Calendar. On December 15<sup>th</sup> Swimmers came from far and wide to attend Northland's first open water swimming championship in seven years at Kai Iwi Lakes. About 120 swimmers took the plunge with most coming from Northland and Auckland, but also from as far afield as Hastings and Mt Maunganui. Meet director and event organiser Ross Gillespie said he was keen to revive the open water event and give swimmers an opportunity to try a different type of swimming. Ross said it had been a while since the last event because of difficulties in finding a suitable date in the current crowded swimming calendar. Ruakaka Surf Life Saving Patrol members helped with water safety at the event and Te Kopuru Fire Brigade and Dargaville Fire Brigade volunteers were on hand to help with first aid, along with a doctor and nurse. Experienced FINA (global swimming governing body) open water referee Paul Matson from Wellington was chief referee. He said he enjoyed himself so much that he planned to return next year to help. Other SNZ technical officials with open water experience came to help on the day, assisted by officials from Northland clubs. We hope that this event will build on the success of 2018.

Long Distance Champs was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> December. This is obviously a busy time for people so close to Christmas but it is growing harder each year to find an ideal space on the calendar plus factoring in the temperature for the outside pool. This year we offered a 400m option as well as the usual 800m and 1500m in the hope it may provide an opportunity for a younger swimmer/ sibling that may not be up to the bigger distance but wanted to participate and this seemed to work well. We had a total of 30 athletes attend the Long Distance Champs and we are hoping that this number will increase in 2019 when we offer the same 3 distance options.

The Douglas Logging Northland Age Groups were held in late January. Once again, we were lucky to have 12 visitors from 3 clubs join the event which gave our Northland swimmers good competition. We had 136 total swimmers with 1006 entries. The weather was fairly good all weekend which added to the event. The committee again shared the jobs, so that the pre-preparation was not too much of a burden on a few.

The committee assisted Sport Northland with the running of Northland Secondary Swimming Champs in February – basically Sport Northland gather entries and the events committee runs the day. This year the format was slightly different with Sport Northland offering entries to competitive and non competitive swimmers. We are lucky that all our qualified technical officials support this day and that we had Beth Finer who did a lot of work behind the scenes on Sport Northland's behalf with the entries.

The final event on the calendar was Rising Stars in March. We had 90 swimmers with 717 entries. The issue of targeting correct swimmers this year by setting entry criteria seemed to work well.

The Events Committee supported six carnivals throughout the season, run by five different clubs. All were considered successes by the organizing clubs.

Finally, the Events Committee believe that we have had a very good season with a good balance of Swimming Northland run carnivals, Club Carnivals and seeing events like the open water swim being added back into the Swimming Northland Calendar, which provide more opportunities for our swimmers to compete locally.



## SWIMMING NORTHLAND TECHNICAL COMMITTEE REPORT

---

Northland continues to hold its own in the area of training swimming technical officials. We continued to focus on training officials throughout the season and brought several in as qualified timekeepers, turn inspectors and judges of stroke, as well as starting several trainees working towards poolside positions.

Carlrine Gillespie was appointed as the Upper North (Northland/Auckland) SNZ Technical Advisory Committee member and at Northland Age Group champs, she assessed several officials for regional and national qualifications – Matt White (JOS), Lindsay Jepsen (regional IOT), Jane Nichols, Rachael Matenga, Marysha Gardner, Dawn Dutton, Matt White, David Finer (national IOT's). Other newly qualified regional IOT's in the past season include James Henderson, Thomas Rickey, Meydi Bell, Sarah Venner, while Dawn Dutton and Sian Williams were assessed as JOS. The focus on training will continue this season, and we encourage all clubs to put forward suitable people to train. In the coming season, we'll be looking to step some of our experienced IOT's up to JOS and have already started referee training (Angela Whittam, David Finer) and starter (Matt White).

Northland officials continue to help at local, area and regional school swimming sports and the ASB Northland Secondary School Championships. Schools and Sport Northland appreciate the help from our officials.

Celia Honiss assisted with running Special Olympics swimming events during the season, along with officials and volunteer helpers.

Many thanks to Beth Finer, who continues to run our control room/admin team with any helpers she can muster, often assisted by Gavin Carroll, Karley Smith, Sam Simons and Kyran Gillespie.

Special recognition must go to Carlrine Gillespie who continues her reign as Northland's top swimming official. She won the Kaipara Sports Awards official of the year title, plus the 2018 Conbrio Northland Sports awards official of the year. This year she was appointed as SNZ's technical advisor for the northern region. She has attended numerous regional and national meets, and officiated at a range of overseas events: the Para Pan Pacific Championships in Cairns last August, the Arafura Games 2019 in Darwin and in early July, will be officiating at the 2019 Pacific Games in Samoa.

Ross Gillespie is also officiating at the Pacific Games this month for the Open Water event as Chief Referee & will then head to South Korea for his appointment as one of only five open water FINA referee's to the 2019 FINA World Open Water Champs. Congratulations Ross on your fantastic achievements which also include his new appointment on the FINA Starter list & re-appointed on the FINA Open Water Referee list. Over the last season Ross has officiated at the 2019 Australian Open Water Championships; International Open Water Marathon Swim event in Taipei, Taiwan; & the Queensland Open Water Champs.

We are fortunate to have people of Carlrine and Ross's calibre to assist with training our technical officials. Dawn Dutton was selected as Northland's emerging Technical Official of the Year – she volunteered to IOT at both Division II and National Age Group Champs and is always willing to help out and engage in further training.

Swimming Northland had good publicity during the past season, with several stories published in the Northern Advocate featuring our swimmers' and technical officials' achievements, along with posts on our website and facebook page.

### **Newspapers**

### SUMMARY OF THE MEET

At this meet Ciara Smith (17) and Hayley McIntosh (19) both qualified for the world championships and represented New Zealand at the 2018 FINA World Short Course Swimming Championships in Hangzhou, China in December 2018. McIntosh, who has swum with the NZ High Performance squad in Auckland for the past two years, made the A qualifying time in 800m free and the B qualifying times in both 200m and 400m free. Smith, who trains in Whangarei under Northwave coach Monica Cooper, made the B qualifying times in both 100m and 200m breaststroke. They joined 16 other swimmers from around New Zealand selected to compete in Hangzhou, China from 11 to 16 December.

Smith won the 200m breaststroke open final swim at short course champs with a national open record time of 2.25.17. She was first in both 100m breaststroke age group race and open final, smashing her own national age group record. She was edged into second place in the 50m breaststroke age group race but came back in the evening open final to win gold. She won silver in the 400m individual medley age group race, setting a new Northland age group and open time, and won bronze in the open event that evening.

McIntosh, up against the country's top freestyle swimmers in all events won silver in 400m and 800m free age group events, and bronze in the open races. She was third in open 200m free and second in 1500m free, traditionally a men's event.

Annabell Simpson (18) of Northwave, shone in her specialist backstroke events. She won silver in her 100m back age group event, setting a new Northland age group and open time. She was first in her 200m age group race and second in the evening's open final event. She won silver also in 50m back, again with a new Northland age group and open record time and was fourth in the open final.

At his first national short course championships Tyler Jepsen (13) of Northwave was a standout, winning gold in his 200m backstroke age group race with a new Northland age group record and making it into the top 30 open swimmers for the evening finals session. He won silver in three other age group races – 100m backstroke, 400m freestyle and 50m backstroke and was 4<sup>th</sup> in 200m freestyle.

Hard on Jepsen's heels was teammate Quin Walden, also 13. Quin was third in all three of his age group backstroke races, 6<sup>th</sup> in both 200m free and 100m IM and 10<sup>th</sup> in 50m fly.

Nellie Clark (14, Northwave) won gold in 14-year women's 50m breaststroke, setting a new Northland age group record, also winning silver in 100m breaststroke. She placed fifth in 200m breaststroke for her age group and swam in the open final.

Emilia Finer (13, Bay of Islands), swimming at NZ Short Course champs for the first time, won silver in 13-year women's 800m free and placed third in her age group for both 400m free and 200m fly, qualifying for the open final session. She was fourth in 13-year women's 400m free and 10<sup>th</sup> in 100m fly.

Madeline Whittam (15, Northwave) won silver in her age group for 200m breaststroke and came 17<sup>th</sup> in the open final. She was fifth in 15-year women's 100m breast and 10<sup>th</sup> in 50m breast.

Paul Linton (18, Bream Bay) placed sixth in his age group in 50m back, setting a new Northland age group and open record, and was 17<sup>th</sup> in the open event. He placed ninth in both 100m and 200m backstroke.

Nathalie Hull (14, Northwave) placed seventh in her age group in 200m breaststroke, 8<sup>th</sup> in 100m breast and 11<sup>th</sup> in 50m breast. Archie White (17, Bay of Islands) was 19<sup>th</sup> in 17- & 18-year men's 100m breaststroke, and 21<sup>st</sup> in both 50m and 200m breast. 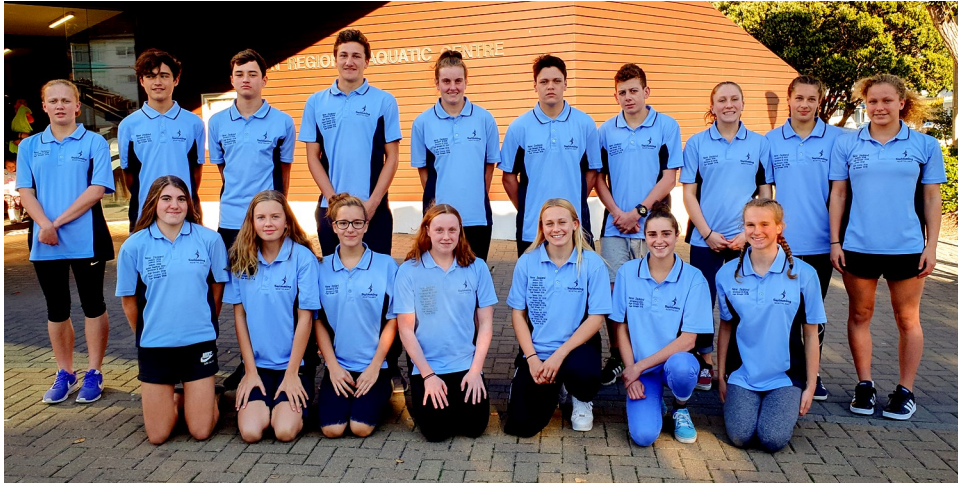

### 1. Statement of Accounting Policies

#### Reporting Entity

These are the financial statements of NORTHLAND SWIMMING ASSOCIATION (INC), a registered body under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with section 23 of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The principal activity of the association is swimming promotion.

#### Measurement Base

### 2. Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in Accounting Policies. All policies have been applied on bases consistent with those used in previous years. A Reviewer was appointed in terms of Section 21 of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.

### 3. Fixed Assets and Depreciation

All fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation.

Depreciation of the assets has been calculated at the maximum rates permitted by the Income Tax Act 2007. The entity has the following asset classes:

#### **6. Accounts Receivable**

Receivables are stated at their estimated realisable value. Bad debts are written off in the year in which they are identified.

#### **8. Contingent Liabilities**
