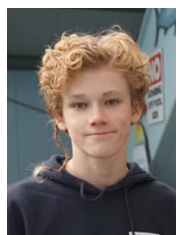

SWIMMER OF THE YEAR—CIARA SMITH SEASONS ACHIEVEMENTS

Ciara chose to only compete within NZ over the past season.

At the NZ Short Course National Championships Ciara won Gold medals for 50m, 100m and 200m Breaststroke for 17-18yrs girls.

She also won silver in the 200m and 400m IM.

Ciara also won a silver medal in the women's 200m Breaststroke, bronze in the Women's 100m breaststroke, bronze in the 50m women's breaststroke and Bronze in the Women's 400m IM.

Ciara was a member of the Swimming NZ Development Squad.

At the Northland Regional Championships Ciara won all her Breaststroke events, also won the 200 and 400IM and the women's 100m Backstroke.

Like all our other qualifiers Ciara was unable to compete at the NZ Open Championships/Olympic Trials due to the cancellation because of Covid 19.

Ciara has continued to break records.

She has been an excellent role model both within Northland and NZ. She was well respected and liked as the Northwave team captain and lead by example.

SWIMMING NORTHLAND SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

Despite a season shortened by the Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown, with many of the major national meets cancelled, highlights abounded in the northernmost swimming region:

NZ Short Course Championships (October 2019):

Ciara Smith (18) produced some excellent performances at this event, winning age group gold medals in all three breaststroke distances, along with silvers in 200m and 400m individual medleys. She also placed second in the open women's 200m breaststroke, third in 400m IM, and fourth in the 50m and 100m breaststroke open events. Tyler Jepsen (14) won age group gold medals in 100m backstroke and 200m backstroke and silver in 50m backstroke. Nellie Clark (15) won three age group silvers across the three breaststroke distances, Madeline Whittam a silver in 200m breaststroke and Nathalie Hull a bronze in 400m IM.

NZ Juniors (Harlequins) March 2020

Thirty Northlanders from five clubs participated in this meet, with an outstanding performance from Hans Haufe. Hans gained first place in all 11-year boys backstroke events with the fastest time out of all the Junior festival events across the country.

Swimming Awards

At the Conbrio Sport Northland Awards, swimming gained recognition in several areas. Ciara Smith was awarded the title of Junior Sportsperson of the Year; Cameron Leslie claimed the award for Disabled Athlete of the Year for his performance representing New Zealand at the World Swimming Championships (where he set a new world record in men's S4 50m free); Monica Cooper, Northwave Coach, was Coach of the Year for her efforts in getting two swimmers on the New Zealand team for the World Short Course Champs and one swimmer to the FINA World Cup Series in Tokyo, Japan. Ross Gillespie was Northland's Official of the Year and Swimming New Zealand's Technical Official of the Year, after being just the second New Zealand technical official to be a referee at a FINA Open Water World Championships.

International Officials

Ross Gillespie was chief referee at the FINA Marathon Swim World Series in Taiwan in September 2019 and was an official at the FINA World Champs Open Water event in Korea, July 2019. He was also the chief referee at the Pacific Games women's open water event in July 2019 and an official at the Queensland Open Water Champs in Brisbane September 2019 and the Australian Open Water Swimming Championships in Adelaide, January 2020. He organised and refereed the Swimming Northland Open Water Champs in December 2019.

Carlrine Gillespie also officiated overseas at the London 2019 World Para Swimming Championships September 2019, the INAS Global Games in Brisbane in October 2019, the Swimming Victoria Opens and World Para Swimming World Series in Melbourne February 2020, and the Pacific Games in Samoa. Carlrine was guest presenter at the Swimming New South Wales Technical Officials Forum in Sydney, July 2019. Celia Honiss officiated at the Pacific Games in Samoa (July 2019).



SWIMMING NORTHLAND EVENTS COMMITTEE REPORT

This year's calendar was compiled with club feedback similar to last year requesting that we have approximately one carnival per month through the winter months, to ensure good numbers attend every carnival. With this in mind, a calendar was compiled and by the time all clubs wishing to hold an event had dates allocated, and national events were entered, The events committee organised and ran the Presentation Carnival in July, Splash Carnival in September, Open Water Swim and Long Distance Champs in December, Age Groups in January and Rising Stars in February.

Presentation Carnival

The Presentation Carnival was held at Whangarei Pool and was very well supported for the first event of the new season. The presentations were held first in the spectator area, which worked well. We were also able to use the time pads which the swimmers enjoyed. We had 109 swimmers and 468 entries, which was similar to the Presentation Carnival held in 2018.

September Splash

Swimming Northland held the September Splash Carnival on 23rd September. There were 76 Athletes entered and 363 entries. In addition to the program we again had a tops and bottoms relay and spot prizes, which was well received. This was Davinia Ripihau's first carnival as meet director and she did a fantastic job.

Open Water

An Open Water Swim at Kai Iwi Lakes appeared back on the Swimming Northland Calendar. On December 15th Swimmers came from far and wide to again attend another successful open water swimming championship. About 100 swimmers took the plunge. Meet director and event organiser Ross Gillespie wanted to run this open water event and give swimmers an opportunity to try a different type of swimming. Ruakaka Surf Life Saving Patrol members assisted with water safety at the event and St Johns were on hand to help with first aid. SNZ technical officials with open water experience returned this year to help on the day, assisted by officials from Northland clubs.

Long Distance

Long Distance Champs was held on 21st December. This is obviously a busy time for people so close to Christmas but it is growing harder each year to find an ideal space on the calendar plus factoring in the temperature for the outside pool. We again offered a 400m option as well as the usual 800m and 1500m, so that we could again provide an opportunity for a younger swimmer/sibling that may not be up to the bigger distance but wanted to participate and this seemed to work well. We had a total of 38 athletes attend the Long Distance Champs, which is 8 up from last year, so we achieved the goal of increasing in 2019.

Northland Age Group Champs

The Douglas Logging Northland Age Groups were held on the 18th to 20th January. Once again, we were lucky to have outside swimmers participate with 2 overseas visitors and 3 Auckland clubs joining the event, which gave our Northland swimmers good competition. We had 153 total swimmers with 1165 entries. The weather was fairly good all weekend which added to the event. The committee again shared the jobs, so that the pre-preparation was not too much of a burden on a few. We again acknowledged those swimmers and officials moving on as well as Ann Bailie for her many years of support as a long serving official.

Swim T3 attended and they also offered \$150 of vouchers which were used as raffle prizes. There were some issues with the data base and times coming through from Bream Bay Swim Carnival which was held in early January, but this was managed well by Beth Finer. Going forward there will be a \$50 late entry fee for this carnival after the psych sheets have been sent out, which should encourage clubs and their families to get their entries in before close off.

Northland Secondary Schools

The committee again assisted Sport Northland with the running of Northland Secondary Swimming Champs in February. Beth Finer even organised the entries and the events committee ran the day. This year the format was the same as last year with Sport Northland offering entries to competitive and non competitive swimmers. We are lucky that all our qualified technical officials support this day and that we had Beth who did a lot of work behind the scenes on Sport Northland's behalf with the entries.

Rising Stars

The final event on the calendar was Rising Stars in February. We had 115 swimmers, up 25 from last year with 744 entries. We were again able to marshal the swimmers outside, as the weather was ideal and it provided more room within the pool complex for spectators. We had some older swimmers volunteer to help throughout the weekend, timekeeping, marshalling and assisting upstairs, which was fantastic. We also had the support of quite a few officials who came and volunteered even though they had no swimmer participating. We were able to run time trials on both days, one during the break on the Saturday and the other between the completion of the swim program and before the start of the parents relay on the Sunday. These time trials were very successful with over half of the swimmers gaining the times they needed. On discussions within the events committee and feedback from coaches and clubs it has been decided that we will make the break time on Saturday shorter/ similar to the Sunday which will make for a smoother Rising Stars in 2021.

There were some incidents of swimmers no showing for their last race so they could do the time trial even though the team managers in question were told that the swimmers couldn't scratch in order to do the time trial. Both managers were new to the role and after a "matter of fact" conversation with both the new team managers in question and the clubs coach. The club were under no illusion as to what the process is and what fee will be per swimmer if it happens again. We have decided to make time for new team managers as part of our team managers briefing going forward at the larger medal meets like Northland Age Groups and Rising Stars, so that we can hopefully avoid a similar situation in the future.

Incidents that occurred were dealt with at the time and discussed with Team Managers. Further training will be added to the next Team Managers meeting at the start of the next season (Presentation Carnival) and again at any meets where we feel there could be swimmers and families new to swimming that are potentially unaware of expectations.

In conclusion

The Events Committee supported eight carnivals throughout the season, run by seven different clubs. All were considered successes by the organizing clubs.

It is a shame that the swim season for our Opens, NAGS and Div II swimmers ended so abruptly due to COVID-19 and we are hoping that this will not have a long lasting impact into our 2020/2021 season.

We have tried to maintain our connection with clubs and the board by facilitating zoom meetings post COVID, so that we could all collaborate on creating the swim calendar for the coming season. We were also able to get a good gauge on where the clubs were at and their individual challenges. Also how we could support them and their families to get back into the swimming season.

The Events Committee believe that we have had a very good season with the exception of its abrupt end. We had a good balance of Swimming Northland run carnivals, Club Carnivals and seeing events like the open water swim being successful for another season was a continued sign of the support we have for swimming meets.



SWIMMING NORTHLAND TECHNICAL COMMITTEE REPORT

We continued to focus on training officials throughout the season and brought several in as qualified timekeepers, turn inspectors and judges of stroke, a referee, and a starter, as well as starting several trainees working towards poolside positions. However, by the close of the season, trainee numbers had dropped off with very few new people stepping up. We will work with clubs to encourage shoulder-tapping within their own ranks to get new trainees on board and begin training new referees and starters in the new season (as official numbers allow) at each carnival.

Officials who gained qualifications over the season were: Dawn Dutton (referee), Matt White (starter), Trudy Derbyshire (regional & national IOT), Marysha Gardner (JOS), Darrin Hawke (regional IOT), Megan Bayer (regional IOT), Cathy Tuato'o (regional IOT).

Northland officials continue to help at local, area and regional school swimming sports and the ASB Northland Secondary School Championships. Schools and Sport Northland appreciate the help from our officials.

Many thanks to Beth Finer, who continues to run our control room/admin team with any helpers she can muster, often assisted by Gavin Carroll, Karley Smith, Sam Simons.

Matt White was our Emerging Technical Official of the Year and Ross Gillespie our Official of the Year. Ross also received Swimming New Zealand's Official of the Year award, as well as Sport Northland's Official of the Year title.

SWIMMING NORTHLAND PUBLICITY REPORT

What an interesting year it has been, drawing abruptly to a close in March 2020 when the nationwide Covid-19 lockdown shut down all competitions and squad training, and saw all planned international meets cancelled.

Once again, Swimming Northland had good publicity during the past season, with several stories published in the Northern Advocate featuring our swimmers' and technical officials' achievements, along with posts on our website and facebook page.

Newspapers

Again, coverage from the Northern Advocate regional newspaper was good – all stories sent in were published along with photos (when available) and frequently made the NZME website. Budget cuts mean the paper no longer has a dedicated sports reporter; however, the former sports reporter is still keen to receive and publish swimming stories. Local papers also published regular updates on their swimmers, with Bay of Islands, Bream Bay and Dargaville clubs being proactive in getting their news out there.

Website

Sian Williams continues to do a great job of running the Swimming Northland website, and ensuring she receives all updates to keep the page looking fresh.

Facebook

The Swimming Northland facebook page continues to be highly successful this year, with more regular updates and plenty of photos. Page follower numbers continue to grow steadily, presently 611 - up from 536 this time last year. Posts reached 1626 people in the last month. Only one major competition, NZ Short Course Championships, went ahead this year and unfortunately, I was overseas while it was on so could not do my usual daily updates on swimmers' progress. NZ Juniors Harlequins turned out to be the last big event our swimmers could participate in for the season and clubs were great at sending in photos that I could use for publicity purposes and alongside daily updates during the competition on facebook, along with hunting through the Swimming New Zealand posts for photos of our swimmers. Throughout lockdown I posted any relevant posts that I came across, to keep some public engagement going with the page.

Looking Forward

This season – if all goes well - we will continue to celebrate the achievements of our swimmers at all levels with stories and facebook posts. I would like all clubs to send to the page items of interest about their club and/or swimmers; and encourage them to send items to their local papers. I will keep working on obtaining photos from national events, whether team, club, or individual swimmers. The need for photos from events is even greater now that our regional paper no longer has a sports reporter and fewer photographers. I will continue to take photos when I can but keep hoping that someone will come out of the woodwork to take on the role of official photographer. Instagram would be great way to target a younger audience, so I seek board permission to start up a Swimming Northland Instagram account.

Parents relay teams were amazing, winning first and fourth place.


